

A BOWLING PATHWAY FOR BIBC BOWLERS

ENTRY POINT 1 – NEW BOWLER

Free coaching sessions available – rink fees payable.....then join!

When: All year on request –up to 4 x 2hr introductory sessions

How: Initially through club manager who will refer to coaches – see coaching noticeboard for more detail.

Attend new bowler/improver organised sessions

When: Throughout year (specifics to be added)

How: Add names to nomination sheets on boards

Book rinks for practise for self or with others

When: Casual sessions and when rinks available

How: Book in person or by telephone up to 7 days in advance

ENTRY POINT 2 – COMPETENT BOWLER

Club Competitions

When: Through winter season -commence Nov, finals Apr – see comps noticeboard

How: Internal Entry form from club & advised through club emails in Sept/Oct

Club Friendlies

When: Mainly through winter season

How: Nomination sheets on boards (organisers – Mens & Ladies Captains & Vice Captains)

Internal Leagues + Ov 70s/Trips Chal'ge

When: Through winter & summer seasons

How: Internal Entry Form from club/Nom sheets & advised through club emails (Mar/Apr for winter Feb/Mar for summer)

Worcs VPs & County Friendlies

When: Through winter seasons

How: Nomination sheet on boards (organisers – Ann & Les Case VPs & Mark Atkins/Chris Jenkins County)

ENTRY POINT 3 – COMPETITIVE BOWLER

Individual County Competitions

When: Through winter season

How: Entry form usually available Dec annually & advised through club emails

Individual National Competitions

When: Summer & winter versions

How: Entry form usually available April annually & advised through club emails

Team National Competitions

When: Through winter season

How: Nomination sheet & speak to team managers

Men's Wessex Teams

When: Through winter season

How: Nomination sheet & speak to team managers
