Dress Code

Club matches – When representing the club in friendly matches or national/county team events, we expect players to wear a Bromsgrove club shirt and currently either grey or white below the waist (but see separate sheet 'Club Kit') dependent upon the dress code noted on the nomination form or as directed by the rules of the competition.

Other Play – This includes roll ups, internal league play and club competitions up to the finals. We have implemented a relaxed dress code that allows players to choose what they wear. We trust and encourage members to dress appropriately for taking part in a game of bowls. Wearing your club shirts for any of these game types is entirely appropriate but certainly not compulsory.

We will still ask members to wear club shirts when playing in club finals as we publish photographs of the event in the club and on the website as well as hoping to stream some of the finals.

Footwear – The bowling carpet is an extremely expensive piece of kit. We need to look after it carefully. All players must wear either regulation bowling shoes or flat soled shoes or plimsolls. Shoes should be put on after entering the club and removed before leaving – this will reduce the risk of stones, grit or other unwanted mess finding its way onto the green.
